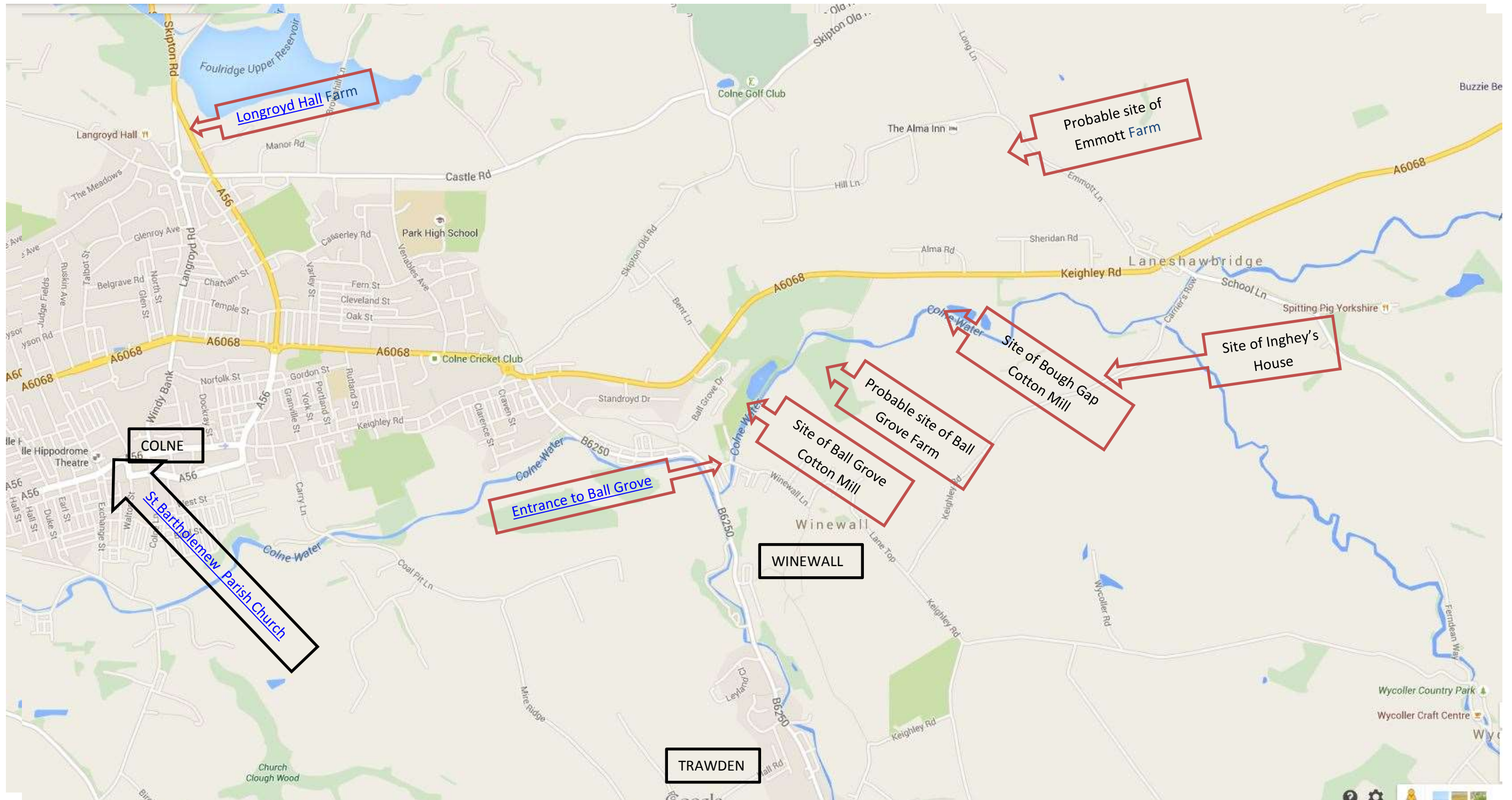


MAP of COLNE

- Notes:
1. Edmund Cockshutt was baptised at St Bartholemew Parish Church on 29 May 1729
 2. Edmund Cockshutt of Ball Grove owned Ballgrove Estate (Farm), Emmott Lane Estate, Cotton Mills in Bough Gap and several other properties in NE Lancashire and NW Yorkshire.
 3. Inghey's Farm was also likely Edmund Cockshutt's property since it was occupied by step son by his third marriage, Richard Folds.
 4. Several of the early Cockshutt baptisms in St Bartholemew Parish Church refer to "Longroyd" as the "abode" of John Cockshutt and it is likely that John was our Edmund Cockshutt's elder brother.
